We will not be responsible for lost, damaged, misdirected, unusable or unreadable content. Before submitting content you will need to complete your registration for the festival via the website.

2. AGE REQUIREMENTS

If the entrant is under 13 years of age, the parent or guardian will need to complete the registration form and include the name of both the participating child or children and the parent or guardian. Submission of the registration form confirms that the parent/guardian has read and agrees on behalf of the child or children to be bound by this agreement and understands, agrees and shall be fully responsible for the submission.
